



Tiny Town ~ No. 461 ½

The finished quilt measures 22" x 25".

Yardage Requirements:

- Asst. light/medium/dark charm squares for roofs – 9 or 5
- Asst. light/medium/dark charm squares for houses – 18
- Additional asst. light/medium/dark charm squares for checkerboards – 12
- Background behind roofs – 1 fat quarter **or** enough scraps to cut 18 squares – 3" x 3"
- Sashing & Outer Borders -- ½ yard **or** a couple of fat quarters **or** fat eighths
- Binding – ¼ yard
- Backing – ¾ yard

Cutting Requirements

1. Select 9 squares and trim them to measure 3 ½" x 3 ½" – cut them like it says in the pattern. Or select 5 squares and trim them to measure 4 ½" x 4 ½" and cut them into quarters on the diagonal. "
2. From each of the 18 charm squares, cut 3 strips – 1 ½" x 5".
 - Trim 2 of the strips to measure 1 ½" x 3 ½".
 - Trim the 3rd strip to measure 1 ½" x 2 ¼". From the remainder, cut 1 square – 1 ½" x 1 ½".
3. From 12 charm squares, cut 3 strips – 1 ½" x 5".
4. Cut 18 squares – 3" x 3". Cut each square in half **once** on the diagonal to yield 2 triangles from each square.
5. Cut 3 strips – 1" x 42" – or 6 strips – 1 ¼" x 21". Join the strips and cut the required lengths.
 - Cut 3 or 4 strips – 2 ¼" x 42" – or 8 strips – 2 ¼" x 21".

Assembling the Quilt Top ~ Making the Houses... For each of the following, substitute these numbers. ☺

2. Trim to 2" x 3 ½".
4. The house block should measure 3 ½" x 4 ¾".
5. Use 1 ½" x 5" strips. Make 18 strip sets. Cut 54 segments.
6. Cut 54 segments.
11. Cut 6 strips 1" x 18 ½".

Finishing the Quilt Top ~ At this point, the quilt top should measure 27 ½" x 32".

- **Side Outer Borders.** Cut 2 strips – 2 ¼" x 21 ¼" – or the length of your quilt top.
- **Top/Bottom Outer Borders.** Cut 2 strips – 2 ¼" x 22" – or the width of **your** quilt top plus the 4" width of the side outer borders.
